Thombarwadi village, Karjat Taluka**



On 22nd April, 200 villagers of Thombarwadi were witness to a permanent solution to their scarcity of water problem faced by them over 20 years. In partnership with Rajkamal Bajaj Foundation a well was constructed at a distance of 2 kms from the village on a piece of land given by a local family where a perennial water spring flows. 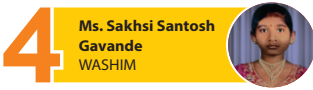
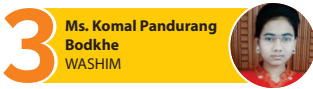

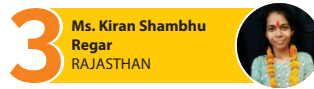
