### Strategic Goals & Impact Targets (2025–2030)

**Vision:** To transform lives of underprivileged rural communities across India through holistic interventions in **education, healthcare, livelihoods, and environmental sustainability**, enabling equitable development and dignity for all.

#### 1. Strategic Goal: Expand Pan-India Geographic Reach

**Objective:** Bring LOLT's programmes to marginalized, remote, and underserved areas across India

##### Geographical Focus:

- **Phase 1: 2025-2027** - Bihar, Jharkhand, Uttarakhand, Goa and Chattisgarh, Karnataka, Telangana, Tamil Nadu
- **Phase 2: 2027 – 2030** - Assam, Sikkim, Leh Ladakh, Himachal Pradesh

##### Impact Targets:

- Operational presence in **10+ new districts** by 2030
- **50,000+ new beneficiaries** reached across all programmes in expansion states
- Forge **10+ grassroots partnerships** with local NGOs, government bodies & institutions

#### 2. Education: Deepen and Expand the Anando Division

**Objective:** Support underprivileged children to complete education and pursue higher studies or vocational paths

##### Initiatives:

- Launch Divisions, Anando and Jagruti depending on the need of the state
- Integrate **digital learning hubs** and mobile classrooms in remote regions
- Scale **mentoring, career guidance and psychosocial support**

##### Impact Targets:

- Reach **50,000 children cumulatively** by 2030
- Ensure 90% rural schools impart quality education

### **3. Healthcare: Expand Palliative & Primary Healthcare Access**

**Objective:** Deliver quality primary healthcare to rural, aging, and terminally ill populations through mobile and home-based models

**Initiatives:**

- Launch **5+ new Mobile Medical Units (MMUs)** in tribal and hilly belts
- Establish **2 Palliative Care Centres** with outreach teams

**Impact Targets:**

- Reach **100,000 patients & caregivers** through mobile health & palliative care
- Offer **home-based care** to end-stage patients

### **4. Livelihoods: Empower Rural Youth and Women through Skilling**

**Objective:** Improve employability and income opportunities for rural populations

**Initiatives:**

- Set up **5 new skill development centres** (esp. in South and Northeast India)
- Focus on **digital literacy, entrepreneurship & job-oriented training**
- Provide **linkages to jobs, markets**

**Impact Targets:**

- Train **15,000+ individuals** by 2030
- Achieve **70%+ employment/self-employment** post training

### **5. Environment: Upskill Farmers & Promote Environmental Sustainability**

**Objective:** Promote sustainable farming practices, improve farmer income and contribute to environmental regeneration

**Initiatives:**

- Train farmers in **organic farming, agroforestry, water conservation**
- Collaborate with state forest departments, CSR partners and agri universities

**Impact Targets:**

- Upskill **10,000+ farmers** in sustainable agriculture by 2030
- Plant and sustain **5 Lakh+ trees** across LOLT intervention areas

### **6. Institutional Strengthening & Impact Measurement**

**Objective:** Enhance internal systems, governance, transparency, and sustainability

**Initiatives:**

- Deploy a **centralised MIS & impact dashboard**
- Publish **annual impact reports** aligned with SDGs
- Mobilize **₹50 crores in funding** through CSR, philanthropy & institutional donors
- Build a **pan-India volunteer force (500+)** for mentoring, medical support, and environmental initiatives
