




Message from the CEO's Desk

Dear Friends,

It is my privilege to present the key highlights of Light of Life Trust's Financial Year 2024–2025—an especially momentous year as we celebrate two decades of service and impact.

From our beginnings in 2004 with just 25 children in the Anando Program, our journey has grown into a nationwide movement of transformation. Today, our initiatives span across Uttarakhand, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Odisha, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, and Goa, with expansion plans underway for Haryana and Delhi. More than 24,000 children have benefitted from the Anando Program to date, many of whom are now contributing meaningfully in organisations across India and abroad.

Through our School Empowerment Programs, we strengthened over 40 secondary schools in Maharashtra and Gujarat this year, enhancing learning environments and outcomes for rural students.

Our mission continues to be powered by a deeply committed donor community. What began with just five supporters has grown into a network of over 2,000 individual donors, 50 corporate partners, and several international foundations across the USA, UK, UAE, and Europe. Their belief in our work reinforces our conviction that compassionate action has no boundaries.

Our healthcare interventions expanded significantly, growing from a single Mobile Medical Unit to five units that collectively served more than 1.5 lakh individuals in underserved regions.

Women's empowerment remained a strong area of focus. Through Vocational Training Centres in Mumbai, Murbad, Karjat, Akola, Rajasthan, and Chhattisgarh, over 3,000 young women gained skills that open pathways to economic independence and self-reliance.

Our environmental initiatives—including farmer training, tree plantation drives, sapling distribution, and the construction of wells in drought-affected regions—impacted thousands of community members. These efforts reflect our long-term commitment to sustainability and rural resilience.

The Tata Mumbai Marathon 2025 marked a proud milestone for the organisation. Light of Life Trust ranked among the Top 5 NGOs and emerged as the second-highest fundraiser—an achievement made possible through collective participation and support.

A major achievement this year was the upgradation of more than 40 schools with the generous support of HDFC Bank, representing a project value of over ₹3.5 crores and significantly enhancing educational infrastructure.

As we reflect on 20 years of service, the year 2025 stands out as a landmark chapter—defined by growth, strengthened partnerships, and unwavering dedication to our vision.

With deep gratitude to our trustees, partners, donors, and the entire Light of Life Trust team, we look forward to continuing our journey of transforming lives and building a future filled with hope.








