With persistent effort and the confidence gained through the Anando ecosystem, Om took a major step forward he started his own mobile repair and accessories shop. Today, Om earns ₹ 1,000/- to ₹ 1,500/- per day, achieving an approximate monthly income of ₹ 35,000/-. Kisan Badve: A tale of dedication and discipline
