
Relief to our Rural Beneficiary Families

All LOLT beneficiaries belong to families from low income groups who suffer the most during a pandemic.

With the Covid - 19 pandemic our beneficiaries were in a crisis due to their inability to earn daily wages during the lockdown period.

Light of Life Trust made concrete efforts to tackle the challenges posed by the COVID - 19 situation and its consequent socio-economic impact on our beneficiaries and their families.

A) Health Care:

- 1. Helplines: Two helplines were set up for information sharing, awareness building, counselling etc. about Covid 19 and its effects. The doctors on call supported callers with any other additional information as required.
- 2. Provision of Hand wash soap.

B) Food:

Food packets containing commodities like rice, wheat flour, daals, pulses, masalas and cooking oil were distributed. LOLT ensured the last mile logistics as the lockdown makes it difficult for relief work to happen. Kirana shops were identified at the Tehsil level who transported the grocery kits to the local village Kirana shop. LOLT Social worker / Parent representative from that village ensured the delivery of the individual grocery kit to beneficiary families from that village.

Online Summer Vacation Programme for Anando students

Online activities were organized during the summer vacations across all regions where the Anando programme is operational over a period of seven days. For the first time an innovative method was adopted due to the national lockdown where social workers recorded each of the activities and shared the same with the students on the Whatsapp groups. In some regions some sessions were undertaken through video conferencing on Google Meet. This was followed by students learning new methods and implementing the same. Some of the activities undertaken were Traditional Hand Art (Mehndi), Essay Writing (Epidemic - Corona), Drawing (Awareness Covid - 19), Clay art, Rangoli, Effective Handwriting, making Mask at home, Best out of Waste, Paper Craft & Others.

Distribution of Sanitizers

Guidance Session – for Anando Plus programme students

Light of Life Trust in collaboration with Gravitas Foundation, Pune organized 2 guidance sessions with Anando Plus students on 22nd & 23rd of July 2020. The session was based on 'Stress Management – in adolescence age (especially in the COVID - 19 pandemic situation). This session was conducted by Mrs. Aasha Khedkar and Mrs. Shivani Kulkarni, counsellors from Reflection Counselling and Psychological Testing Centre, Pune. 82 Anando Plus students participated in the session which



covered the following topis - Corona pandemic and its impact on social, economical and educational field, how to tackle the COVID - 19 pandemic in a positive way, and mental health and its balance in the adolescence age.



Anant Programme – Online Classes

Anant programme (in partnership with Flowering Tree Inc., USA) is conducting the programmes through online sessions with innovative methods to retain the student's interest in music. Anant teachers are using different methodologies which involves usage of online apps and offline instruments to deliver the sessions in an intuitive and creative manner. On 11th September 2020, an online Dance workshop was organized for the Anant Programme students in collaboration with Artscape. This session was facilitated by Artscape Founder and Managing Trustee, Ms. Kamalika Guha Thakurta along with Anant programme dance teacher from Karjat region. In this session students were also taught about different features of video conferring app, Zoom. This will enable them to use technology at their best and help them in collaborative learning.







Sanitary Napkin Distribution

On 17th, 22nd & 23rd September, 2020 the Medical Mobile Units (MMU) in Karjat & Murbad distributed 336 sanitary napkin packets donated by NGO Akshara to adolescent girls and women in Dhasai village, Murbad and Varne, Varne Katkarwadi, Navsuchiwadi & Lobhewadi villages, Karjat Taluka, Raigad District. This activity was undertaken after the awareness session on Menstruation & Menstrual hygiene conducted for the adolescent girls and women belonging to these areas.



Workshop

Workshops have been the backbone of Project Anando which has resulted in imparting important personality development oriented and information-based learning. It has always been a one to one interactive session throughout the years. But this pandemic taught us how to adopt innovative ways in continuing the planned workshop activities for the academic across all LOLT regions. Anando Plus task force played an especially important role in recording the planned sessions and distributing it to students. Methodologies like video conferencing, session video recording and distribution through offline methods, online video streaming and feedback & discussion through WhatsApp and over the phone were followed.







Capacity Building Webinar on Understanding National Education Policy 2020



A webinar was organised for all the staff and team members of LOLT on 11th August 2020 to understand the NEP and its implications on our work. The webinar took place in the form of a panel discussion in which experienced and senior team members of LOLT took the lead to present different sections of the policy to the participants, whilst sharing their perspective on how the policy will be applicable and relevant to LOLT. The daylong session ended with valuable inputs on the way ahead from Ms. Kamal Damania, COO, LOLT and Mr. Ramesh Daswani, CEO, LOLT who guided the team on important aspects of overall impact and implementation strategy.

Yavatmal Region - Completion of 1 year

The first anniversary of Light of Life Trust's presence in Yavatmal District was celebrated on 29th July 2020 and on this occasion, Mr. Dipak Bijamwar & Mrs. Bijamwa sponsored 40 sets of 10th standard textbooks worth Rs. 26000/- for the Anando programme beneficiaries. A small distribution ceremony at the LOLT Yavatmal project office was organized where the books were distributed to the students in the presence of the dignitaries following all the social distance norms and necessary precautions.





2nd Anniversary of Miyawaki Forest

Light of Life Trust celebrated the 2nd anniversary of its Miyawaki forest at Tiware, Karjat on 1st September 2020. Miyawaki is a technique that helps build dense, native forests. The approach is supposed to ensure that plant growth is 10 times faster and the resulting plantation is 30 times denser than usual. We are feeling extremely happy to share that within 2 years the height of the plants has reached up to 20 feet and some of them have even started flowering. This project is implemented under the initiative of the Environment Conservation Programme of Light of Life Trust.

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
