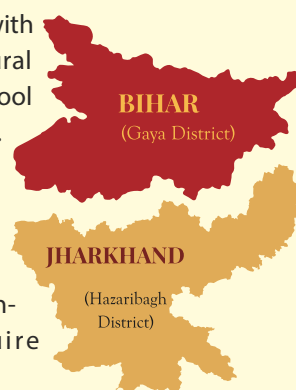

District Education officers visits Washim centres

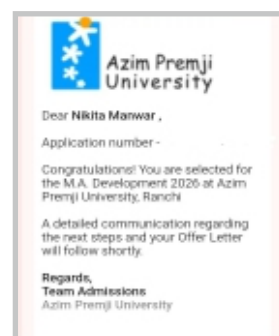
